

THE MARY PATRICIA BRUNSMAN LIBRARY SCHOLARSHIP MEMORIAL AWARD

Patricia Brunsmann was the director of the Nanuet Public Library for thirty years. Her family established the Mary Patricia Brunsmann Library Scholarship Memorial Award in her memory. The Award is administered by the Library Association of Rockland County (LARC), an organization open to anyone interested in libraries. Members include trustees, librarians, support staff and retired professionals.

The Award will be given annually to a candidate who is pursuing a Master's degree in Library and Information Science and who meets the criteria for entrance into an ALA accredited school or is already enrolled in an ALA approved MLS program.

The winner of the Award will be given a monetary stipend of an amount to be determined annually. The amount of the Award for 2014 is \$1,000. Applicants must be current LARC Members. (If necessary please download the membership application and submit with check along with this application.)

The recipient of the Scholarship must accept the award in person at the annual LARC event designated each year for the presentation of awards.

Guidelines

The candidate must:

- possess a BA or BS degree
- be a resident or past recent resident of Nanuet, New York or live or work in Rockland County if there is no candidate from Nanuet
- submit a completed 3-part application
